DESIGN FOR A HANDKERCHIEF.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,494, dated July 31, 1888.

Application filed June 13, 1888. Serial No. 277,025. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARY R. MOORE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Washington, in the District of Columbia, have invented
5 and produced a new and original Design for Handkerchiefs; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
10 My invention relates to designs for handkerchiefs; and it consists in the unique decoration of such article.

The essential feature of my design consists of a handkerchief with a Greek border adjacent to the edges thereof, having corner intersections of a double flag and inclosing a central field having contiguous portrait-spaces
15 with crossed flags above the same.

In the accompanying drawing I have illustrated a handkerchief in plan view having my
20 design thereon.

A indicates the Greek border, intersected by double flags B, arranged in the corners. The border A incloses a central field, C, having portrait-spaces *c* contiguously arranged therein, with crossed flags D arranged thereover. 25

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

A design for a handkerchief, as herein shown and described, consisting of an edge Greek border intersected at the corners by a double flag and inclosing a field having portrait-spaces therein with crossed flags arranged above, as set forth. 30 35
