

DESIGN FOR A HANDKERCHIEF.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,513, dated August 7, 1888.

Application filed July 13, 1888; Serial No. 279,871. Term of patent 31 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH M. JONES, of
Paris, in the county of Bourbon and State of Kentucky, have invented and produced a new 5 and original Design for a Campaign-Handkerchief, of which the following is a full, clean, and exact specification.

Reference is had to the accompanying drawing, which forms part of this specification, to and which represents a face or one-side view of a campaign handkerchief having my new design.

The figure in the drawing represents a bandana handkerchief, A, having in its center and in each of its corners a figure, A', repress 15 senting the Stars and Stripes or national flag of the United States of America.
