

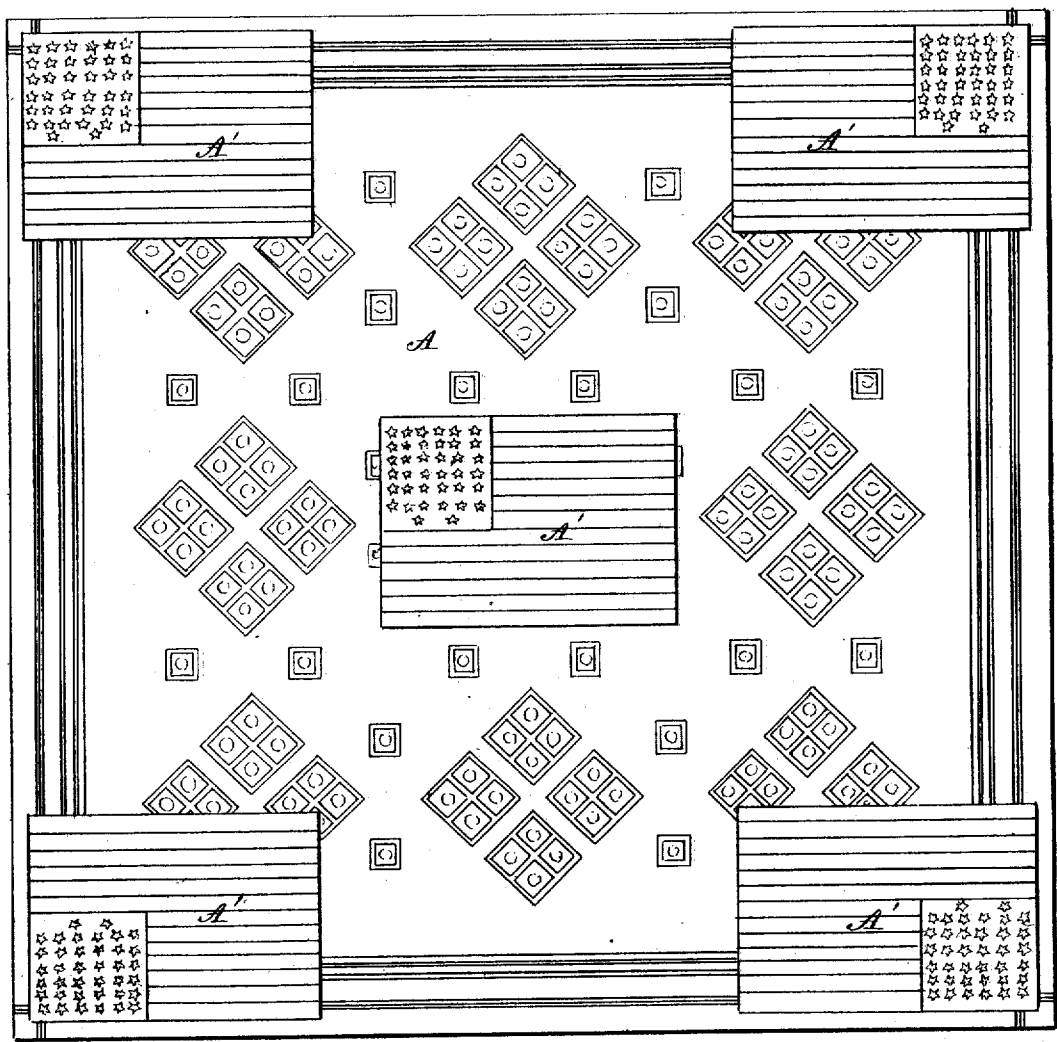

## DESIGN FOR A HANDKERCHIEF.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,513, dated August 7, 1888.

Application filed July 13, 1888. Serial No. 279,871. Term of patent 3½ years.

### *To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOSEPH M. JONES, of Paris, in the county of Bourbon and State of Kentucky, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Campaign-Handkerchief, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact specification.

Reference is had to the accompanying drawing, which forms part of this specification, and which represents a face or one-side view of a campaign handkerchief having my new design.

The figure in the drawing represents a bandana handkerchief, A, having in its center and in each of its corners a figure, A', representing the Stars and Stripes or national flag of the United States of America.

I claim—

The design for a campaign handkerchief, as shown in the accompanying drawing.
