

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOUIS ANNIN AMES, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city of New York, borough of Manhattan, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Banner, Flag, Pennant, Sign, Emblem, or Article of a Similar Nature, of which the following is a description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof. The figure is an elevation of a banner

showing my new design.

Said design is a "welcome home" banner and consists of a center field of white surrounded by a red border and containing a green wreath branching from the sides of a shield in red, white and blue, and the representation of a blue star between the terminals of the wreath.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a banner, flag, pennant, sign, emblem or article of a similar nature as shown and described.
